- Be willing to teach in accordance with Calvary's statement of faith.

- Create a warm environment that fosters friendship and meaningful relationships.
- Create a welcoming environment for visitors and new members.
- Help others engage the Bible by leading a lesson or group discussion.
- Communicate regularly with group members regarding upcoming events and socials.
- Inform the Discipleship Office of meeting details, leadership needs, and by taking roll.
- Engage with the Discipleship Office through weekly emails, curriculum approval, and by attending semi-annual training sessions.
