Distortions of Marriage - Polygamy, Divorce, Infidelity

Deuteronomy 24:1-4

Matthew 19:1-12

Two Emphases from Matthew 19:1-12

- Marriage, as God designed it, is between one man and one woman in a binding, covenantal monogamous relationship until death do they part.
- Just because something is permissible, does not necessarily make it ideal.

Two Predominant Views of Divorce Among Evangelicals

- Permanence
- Permissible

When thinking about distortions of Marriage and Sexuality, Remember:

- The Bible should inform our sexual ethic
- Marriage, Sex, and Orgasm are good gifts, but terrible gods
- Keeping the marriage covenant is a gospel issue
- Sexual sin impacts more than me and more than my body
- The ground is level at the foot of the cross
- The Gospel should inform our response to the failure of ourselves and others

If you're struggling:

- If sin is present pray for conviction
- If conviction has come pray for repentance
- If repentance pray for action
- If action pray for perseverance
- No matter what lean on the grace of God

If you're near others who are struggling:

- Move toward them, not away
- Guard yourself
- Be gracious to them as God has been to you
- Declare and demonstrate a better way

If this all feels distant:

- Walk carefully
- Pray earnestly
